Description: EKOS was commissioned by Scottish Enterprise, in partnership with the Scottish Government and Creative Scotland, to conduct an appraisal of possible options for a new film and TV production studio in Scotland.

The study sought to: establish the scale and nature of potential demand for a new studio facility in Scotland; appraise possible sites and facility models; develop and appraise the commercial viability; examine management and delivery options; and assess the likely economic impact of a new studio. The research included detailed analysis of market data along with extensive consultation with the film and TV industry and a range of stakeholders. EKOS led a multidisciplinary team of architects, quantity surveyors, engineers and acoustics experts, and the final report included clear recommendations for action and next steps.

Outputs: The report has been published and, in line with the recommendations, has informed a formal market testing exercise seeking private sector interest in the development.
